

Edgewater Park Campground

Rules and Regulations



Rent

- All rent must be paid in advance.
- Each campsite is limited to one family per site which includes parent(s) and unmarried children.
- Campers are allowed only two guests per week and require payment for designated parking.
- Campers are responsible for their guests. No Subleasing.
- Additional guests are allowed on a case-by-case basis as approved by owner a week in advance.
- Campsites are from electric pole to electric pole. Do not use or park on another campsite.
- The park is not responsible for loss, theft, vandalism or injury and illness.
- If paying for camping per day, Check-Out Time is 12:00pm. Only one camper per camp site.

Conduct

- Rowdiness, noisy, disorderly or ill-mannered conduct will not be tolerated. Please watch profanity.
- Please respect other campers and cleanup after yourself.
- Adults are responsible for the care and conduct of their children.
- Children, age 5 and younger, must be accompanied by an adult including playground and restrooms.
- Quiet hours – 10:30pm to 8:00am.

Utilities and Maintenance

- *Warning:* The treated well water may or may not be safe to drink. Bring drinking water.
- No hoses or power washers allowed. Washing of boats, campers or vehicles is not permitted.
- All outside lights are to be turned off during the day.
- No building of permanent structures including decks and satellite dishes.
- All water leaks must be fixed immediately.
- Sewer line must have no sewer gas; use coupling, doughnut, or duct tape as last resort.
- Heat tape should be used on water lines in cold weather.
- All trash and garbage must be placed into plastic bags or a container that does not leak.
- Accumulation of trash/garbage is not permitted outside and must be emptied in dumpster before leaving.
- Boxes are to be broken down before putting into dumpster.

Vehicles

- Speed limit is 5 mph throughout the entire park.
- Boat utility or horse trailers are not permitted in camping area. Designated areas are provided at an additional charge.

Docks

- Docks and boat launch are only for campers that have rented a dock. All other campers are not permitted on docks.
- No fishing or swimming from docks.
- Children must have life jackets on dock and are only permitted on dock when accessing boat.

Pets

- Campers are allowed pets. Campers must complete the Pet Policy and Registration.
- Guests are not permitted pets.
